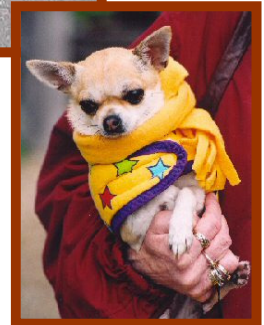



We welcome fun loving, well-socialized canines to participant in the “Tail End” section of the Parade as long as owners agree to the following:

- **Dogs must be current on all vaccinations**
- **Dogs must have (and be wearing) a current dog license**
- **Dogs must be leashed at all times**
- **For the safety of your dog(s) and other street festival visitors, choke, prong, and spike collars are strictly prohibited**
- **Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to accompany a dog without an adult with them at all times**
- **Aggressive dogs are not permitted on the premises. Dogs must be removed immediately at first sign of aggression**
- **Female dogs in heat are prohibited from the Festival**
- **Do not stop the flow of the Parade with the exception of a train passing through**
- **No performances (tricks) during the Parade**
- **To keep children safe from moving Parade traffic, do not throw candy, beads, or other items to spectators**
- **Please bring a canine waste bag with you and dispose of any collections properly**

***Parade Route & Information***

The parade will assemble at **Skate Park Dr.** and **END** at the intersection of **Front Street and Buttermilk Alley.**

Map, line-up instructions, and other information will be emailed approximately one week before the event.

Please note that we reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the premises at any time.

***Please be considerate of the  
“NO DOG ZONES”***

Children’s Area: We ask that you not take your canine into the Children’s Area (off Martin St). There will be many hands-on art projects and we’d hate to have little pink handprints on your pup!

***Parade Awards***

Trophies and plaques will be awarded during Opening Ceremonies (Gazebo). This year, awards will be presented to the top parade entries in the following categories: Floats, Tail End, and 5 and under.
